

# The Digital Divide

## Lower Class

Only **45%** of families making **\$30,000** or less have Internet access



**28 million** adults say they do not have Internet at home because they can't afford it

Those without access are less prepared for college and future careers

## Middle-Upper Class

**74%** of students have a class with online components



**100%** of public schools have some sort of Internet access

Families making **\$75,000+** are **20X** more likely to have Internet access



Those with access have an advantage when it comes to completing schoolwork at home, attending college, and joining the workforce

People with college degrees are **10X** more likely to have Internet access at work
